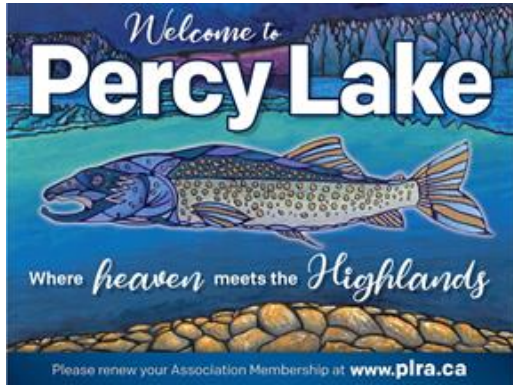




Percy Lake Update December 2024
